Cosmetic Procedures



Liposculpture

Liposculpture, aka Lipo is the art of safely shaping the body by removing stubborn fat with a strategically planned method.

The surgeon performs liposuction on the front and back of the body to achieve maximum results with Liposculpture. Depending on the patient, the healing process can take three to six months.



Abdominoplasty

Abdominoplasty, aka a Tummy Tuck, is a plastic surgery operation aiming to flatten the stomach and tighten the muscles in the area by removing excess fat and skin from the abdomen's middle and lower abdominal regions.

In addition, this procedure aims to reshape the abdomen's loose areas.



Breast Procedures

We offer breast augmentation, reduction, and lift. Breast enlargement, breast implant, or breast augmentation surgery; is a surgical operation to change the breast's size, shape, and form. Breast reduction, also called mammoplasty, is a plastic surgery operation that aims to reduce the size, volume, and weight of the breasts.



Thighplasty

Thighplasty, also known as thigh lift, is a surgical procedure that is designed to improve the appearance of the thighs.

The procedure involves removing excess skin and fat from the inner or outer thighs to create a smoother and more toned appearance.



Brachioplasty

Brachioplasty, also known as an arm lift, is a surgical procedure designed to improve the appearance of the upper arms by removing excess skin and fat.

This procedure is popular among individuals who have experienced significant weight loss, as well as those who have excess skin due to aging or genetics.



Gluteoplasty

Brazilian butt lift aka a bbl is a surgical procedure in which unwanted excess fat, such as the waist and abdomen, is removed by liposuction and injected into the hips and buttocks. It is a surgical procedure involving fat transfer to the hips and buttocks.

In contrast to implants in Brazilian butt lift surgery, The patient's fat is used to improve the size and shape of the hip and buttocks. Therefore, this is the most natural way to shape the hips.



Rhinoplasty

A nose job or rhinoplasty, with its medical name, is a surgical operation that aims to reshape the nose. The nose is the most prominent organ that creates the appearance of the face, thanks to its central location.

Rhinoplasty will be the best solution for those who are unsatisfied with the shape or size of their nose or those with breathing problems.



Blepharoplasty

The procedure surgically removes excess fat, muscle and skin from the upper and lower eyelids to redefine the shape of the eye.

While an eyelid lift cannot alter dark circles or fine lines and wrinkles around the eye ("crow's feet"), it can address age-related drooping or puffy eyelids and create a more refreshed, youthful appearance. An eyelid lift can also correct drooping eyelids that are interfering with vision.



Facelift

A face-lift is a cosmetic surgical procedure to create a younger look in the face. The procedure can reduce sagging skin. It can also help smooth folds of skin on the cheeks and jawline. A face-lift is also called a rhytidectomy.

Depending on the degree of change you'd like to see, your facelift choices include a traditional facelift, limited incision facelift or a neck lift.



Otoplasty

Otoplasty is a procedure that alters the structure of the outer ear. Otoplasty is most often cosmetic. The most common form of otoplasty is known as ear pinning.

Ear pinning is done to flatten protruding ears so they do not have as pronounced an appearance.



Mentoplasty

Mentoplasty refers to surgery in the chin area. One of the best things about it is that it can be precisely tailored to the needs of the patient. This type of surgery can be used to increase the projection forward and/or downward—of the chin, with implants or by altering the bone position itself," she explains.

Mentoplasty can also be done to decrease the projection of the chin by shaving the bone. Additionally, mentoplasty can help alter the appearance of the neck..



Orthognathic Surgeray

Orthognathic Surgery (Corrective Jaw Surgery) involves moving the bones of the upper or lower jaw or both. The jaws are lengthened or shortened, moved up or down, in or out, resulting in a more harmonious bite and facial appearance. Orthognathic surgery is needed when jaws and teeth don't meet correctly. Repositioning the jaws so that the teeth meet (occlude) correctly improves jaw joint function and chewing (mastication) ability, and can also improve speech, breathing, sleep apnea, periodontal (gum) health and facial aesthetics

Intimate Procedures



Gender Affirming-Vaginoplasty

Gender-affirming vaginoplasty is a surgical procedure aimed at constructing or reconstructing a vagina for transgender women assigned male at birth who seek to align their physical appearance with their gender identity. This can significantly improve quality of life and contribute to psychological wellbeing.



Gender Affirming -Phalloplasty

Gender-affirming phalloplasty is a surgical procedure designed for transgender men assigned female at birth who wish to create a penis that aligns with their gender identity. The surgery typically involves using tissue from other parts of the body, such as the forearm, thigh, or abdomen, to construct a penis.



Voice Feminization/ Masculinization

Voice feminization/masculinization surgery is a procedure to raise/lower the pitch of your voice or make it sound higher/lower.

Surgery changes the length, size or tightness of your vocal cords.



Pectoral Implants

Pectoral augmentation — or "pec implants" — adds definition and contour to your chest. Successful pec augmentation uses a silicone gel implant to extend the depth of your muscle so it appears more chiseled and defined.

This surgery focuses on your upper chest where your pectoral muscles are, right over your breastbone.



Mastectomy

Gender-affirming mastectomy is a type of surgery that removes breast tissue, tightens the skin, and can adjust nipple placement to provide the desired results of a more masculine-looking chest.

Mastectomies started as a way for surgeons to remove tumors from the breast tissue.



Labiaplasty

The labiaplasty procedure aims to decrease the size of the labia minora (inner tissues of the female genitalia) so that it is flush with the labia majora (outer part of the female genitalia).

This procedure involves utilizing several different surgical techniques depending on the patient's specific situation.

Bariatric Procedures




Gastric Bypass

Gastric Bypass is a type of weight loss surgery that involves creating a small pouch from the stomach and connecting the newly created pouch directly to the small intestine. After gastric Bypass, ingested food will enter this small pouch in the stomach and then directly into the small intestine, bypassing most of the stomach and the first section of the small intestine.



Gastric Sleeve

A gastric sleeve is a surgical procedure for weight loss. This procedure is usually done laparoscopically, which involves the insertion of small instruments through multiple small incisions in the upper abdomen. During the laparoscopic gastric sleeve procedure, 80% of the stomach is removed, forming a long tubular pouch the size and shape of a banana



Sleeve vs Bypass

Both surgeries are effective for significant long-term weight loss, but they differ in their approach, complexity, potential benefits, and risks. Gastric bypass typically results in more rapid and slightly greater weight loss but comes with a higher risk of surgical complications and nutritional deficiencies compared to the gastric sleeve.

Dental Procedures



Veneers

Veneers are custom-fit, wafer-thin shells that your dentist permanently bonds to the fronts of your teeth to improve the appearance of your smile.

These veneers can hide stained, chipped, crooked, or gapped teeth.



Dental Implants

Dental implants are metal fixtures surgically fastened to your jawbone below the gums, onto which artificial teeth can be mounted. These metal implants become anchored to your bone through osseointegration (the bone fuses to the metal). This process provides stable support you can rely on while eating and speaking.



Clear Aligners

Aligners are thin, clear trays made to fit your teeth. Unlike metal braces, aligners are removable. The patient is responsible for putting them in and taking them out. Patients receive sets of aligners designed to move their teeth using the same method as braces: constant, gentle pressure.



Crowns

Also known as a cap, a dental crown is most often a tooth-colored prosthetic designed to cover a damaged tooth in a fixed position.

Once inserted, a crown can strengthen the tooth, improving its overall appearance and alignment in the mouth.



Dentures

Dentures are custom-made replacements for missing teeth and can be taken out and put back into your mouth.

While dentures take some getting used to and will never feel the same as natural teeth, today's dentures are natural looking and more comfortable than ever.



Dental Restoration

Dental restoration refers to various dental procedures aimed at repairing or restoring the function, integrity, and morphology of missing tooth structure, which can be caused by decay, deterioration of a previously placed restoration, or fracture of a tooth. Common dental restoration procedures include fillings and root canals.

Both procedures are fundamental in restorative dentistry, helping to restore dental health and functionality while preventing further damage and the need for more extensive procedures.
